



Around the Mountains; Vail hopes to replace H-2B drivers

VAIL — Vail town officials last year had 35 Australians with H-2B visas driving buses. With none of them coming back, the town is scrambling to recruit drivers, going to Yosemite and other national parks to see if summer-time bus drivers want winter jobs.

Although the town isn't ready to cut back service, if that happens, the evening schedule will be hit first. Some routes to outlying neighborhoods currently get buses every 15 minutes, notes the Vail Daily.
